This seminar will describe details of the Pilot Program where squadrons may volunteer to teach a new course using course materials delivered by E-Books. The Pilot Program consists of two components:

- The new “Boat Handling” (formally Seamanship) Course. It is the first course to be revised to exist as separate seminars. For Boat Handling there are six independent seminars that can be ordered individually or as a package. The six seminars are:

 - Docking and Undocking with

- Boating at Sea with Confidence
- Anchoring with Confidence
- Emergencies on Board
- Practical Knot Tying
- E-Books Materials Delivery. Allows the SEO to place orders on-line or via a form; and receive the student guide redemption key for each item. The SEO will then distribute the redemption key to students who will use it to download the materials.

Seminar content is essential knowledge for all SEOs, and is also useful to squadron members who may be future students. We recommend all SEOs attend.

Seminar will also provide background data on E-Books and the Seminar based Course concepts.
